

**Position:** Lodge Executive Vice Chief

**Term Length**

One Year Term starting on August 1<sup>st</sup> and ending on the next August 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Qualifications**

- Must be under the age of 21 throughout the duration of the term
- Must be a member in good standing registered with Totanhah Nakaha Lodge and Northern Star Council.
- Must be able to commit the time and effort needed to effectively conduct the office.

**Responsibilities**

- Assists the lodge chief, as directed by him, to carry out the operations of the lodge.
- Assumes other responsibilities and duties as assigned by the lodge chief.
- Promotes participation in lodge, section, region, and national events.
- Assumes the responsibilities of the lodge chief when he is unable to attend.
- Serves as an example of the ideals of the BSA and the Order of the Arrow.
- Wears the Scout uniform correctly.
- Assures that the lodge's camping promotion program is operating efficiently and effectively throughout the council.
- Manages the Lodge's Leadership Development Program through the use of the LLDC as well as through year-round training opportunities for Arrowmen to attend and attendance at the National Leadership Seminar.
- Oversees the OA's involvement in the council's efforts when it comes to Cub Scout, Boy Scout, and Venturing recruitment and retention and offers ideas as to how the lodge should be more involved.
- Works with chapters in utilizing the OA troop/team representative program in both the lodge program, and most importantly to benefit the troop's programs.
- Monitors the OA's involvement in the council Scoutreach efforts through the use of either the OA Scoutreach Mentoring Program, or other means as directed by the Scoutreach Director.
- Assures the overall Awards and Recognition activities and programs that the lodge undertakes.
- Oversees other initiatives that the council wishes for the Order of the Arrow to undertake (i.e. JLC, etc)
