

Position: Lodge Vice Chief - Program

Term Length

One Year Term starting on August 1st and ending on the next August 1st.

Qualifications

- Must be under the age of 21 throughout the duration of the term.
- Must be a member in good standing registered with Totanhan Nakaha Lodge and Northern Star Council.
- Must be able to commit the time and effort needed to effectively conduct the office.

Responsibilities

- Assists the lodge chief, as directed by him, to carry out the operations of the lodge.
- Assumes other responsibilities and duties as assigned by the lodge chief.
- Promotes participation in lodge, section, region, and national events.
- Serves as an example of the ideals of the BSA and the Order of the Arrow.
- Wears the Scout uniform correctly.
- Oversees the planning, execution, and evaluation of all lodge events (excluding training sorts of events).
- Manages the Lodge's attendance and cooperation for events of Northern Star Council.
- Assists the Section Conclave by way of actively encouraging lodge members to attend as well as to prepare the lodge's areas of responsibilities at the Section Conclave.
- Assures the planning and execution of the lodge's contingents to major national events of the Order of the Arrow (i.e. NOAC, National Leadership Summit, etc.)
- Using the resources of the lodge, promotes participation of the OA's National High Adventure Programs (OA Wilderness Voyage, OA Trail Crew, and OA Ocean Adventure) and assists those Arrowmen in arranging their involvement.
- Coordinates the lodge's participation in service projects that benefit both council properties as well as the communities that Northern Star Council affects.
