Scholarships may be granted for up to 40% of the total fee, not exceeding \$270.00.

Please submit a separate scholarship form for each member. All scholarships will be confirmed by letter to the parent (for a youth, or the member (if an adult) listed on the form.

Guidelines:

- 1) Arrowman should participate in a unit fundraising event and/or Popcorn Sale.
- 2) Forms must be signed by a unit leader.
- 3) Forms must be submitted by **March 1st 2015**
- 4) Scholarships can be given for a maximum of 40% of the conference fee, not exceeding \$270.
(Fee for the conference is \$675)
- 5) Recipients are asked to send a thank you letter to the Lodge Executive Committee.
